DARK STAR HOPHEAD 3.8% ABV
Fuller's Brewery, London. Est. 1845

This pale golden ale has a strong floral aroma, with elderflower notes from its Cascade hops, leading to a clean-drinking and full-flavoured (yet extremely drinkable) character.
Hops: Cascade, Liberty **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



OAKHAM JHB 3.8% ABV

Oakham Ales, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1993
This golden beer is light and refreshing in character, with characteristic citrus fruit notes and a crisp flavour, leading to a dry, hoppy finish.
Hops: Challenger, Mount Hood **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



EAGLE BOMBARDIER 4.1% ABV

Eagle Brewery, Bedfordshire. Est. 1876
This distinctive classic English bitter is amber in colour, with a fruity aroma and a perfect balance of rich malt, tangy hops and sultana fruit, culminating in a soft, spicy finish.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



BRAINS SA 4.2% ABV

Brains Brewery, Cardiff. Est. 1882
This copper-coloured beer has hints of spirit in the inviting aroma, leading to a fine balance of nutty richness from the malt and a satisfying dryness imparted by the blend of hops.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



SHEPHERD NEAME SPITFIRE 4.2% ABV

Shepherd Neame Brewery, Kent. Est. 1698
This deep amber-coloured beer is brewed with the finest Kentish hops, resulting in a floral aroma, leading to hints of marmalade, pepper and fruit, balanced by a mellow malt character.
Hops: Challenger, First Gold, Goldings, Target **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



WYCHWOOD HOBGOBLIN GOLD 4.2% ABV

Banks's Brewery, West Midlands. Est. 1890
This golden beer contains generous hop notes and a mouth-watering flavour from the malt and wheat combining to deliver a well-balanced character and a citrus hop kick in the finish.
Hops: Admiral, Cascade, Citra, Hallertau Blanc, Nelson Sauvin, Summit **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



BRAINS THE REV JAMES ORIGINAL 4.5% ABV

Brains Brewery, Cardiff. Est. 1882
This mahogany-coloured beer is rich and well balanced, with a mellow, malty flavour which unexpectedly gives way to a clean, refreshing finish.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



EXMOOR GOLD 4.5% ABV

Exmoor Brewery, Somerset. Est. 1980
This classic golden ale has a juicy malt aroma, with hints of citrus hops and vanilla, while the subtle malt sweetness in its flavour leads to a refreshing, bittersweet finish of citrus, toffee and vanilla.
Hops: Celeia, Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



MORLAND OLD SPECKLED HEN 4.5% ABV

Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799
This amber-coloured beer has a superb fruity aroma, with its warming malt and toffee character balanced by fruity notes and a subtle bitterness, leading to a refreshing, dry finish.
Hops: Challenger, First Gold, Goldings **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



WYCHWOOD HOBGOBLIN RUBY 4.5% ABV

Wychwood Brewery, Oxfordshire. Est. 1983
This full-bodied, ruby-coloured beer delivers a delicious chocolate and toffee malt flavour, balanced by a moderate bitterness and an overall fruity, mischievous character.
Hops: Bobek, Fuggles, Goldings, Herkules **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



FIRE ISLAND BUFFALO 4.6% ABV

Evan Evans Brewery, Carmarthenshire. Est. 2004
This dark amber organic beer is gluten free. The full and lasting dry spice aroma is complemented by a rich, full-bodied malt flavour and balanced by hedgerow fruit notes.
Hops: Ariana, Magnum, Mandarina Bavaria **Allergens:** none

HOOK NORTON OLD HOOKY 4.6% ABV

Hook Norton Brewery, Oxfordshire. Est. 1849
This popular tawny-red bitter has a strong, fruity, malty aroma and palate, with a balance of subtle hoppiness and hints of crystal malt, creating a well-rounded, slightly sweet character.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



ADNAMS BROADSIDE 4.7% ABV

Adnams Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1872
This classic beer is a deep ruby colour, rich in fruit cake aromas, with hints of almond and fruit in the smooth, malty flavour, leading to a balanced, lasting finish.
Hops: First Gold **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



RINGWOOD FORTYNINER 4.9% ABV

Ringwood Brewery, Hampshire. Est. 1978
This golden-brown beer has a light, fresh, floral aroma, with a rounded malt flavour balanced by a moderate bitterness which leads to pleasing bittersweet notes in the finish.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings, Progress, Sovereign **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



SHEPHERD NEAME BISHOPS FINGER 5.0% ABV

Shepherd Neame Brewery, Kent. Est. 1698
This chestnut-brown-coloured ale has a complex, fruity, toffee aroma, leading to a firm malt base in the flavour, complemented by notes of dark fruit, pepper and cinnamon.
Hops: Challenger, First Gold, Goldings, Target **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



RINGWOOD OLD THUMPER 5.1% ABV

Ringwood Brewery, Hampshire. Est. 1978
This deep amber-coloured beer has a peppery, spicy aroma, with an excellent balance of malt and hops in the flavour, delivering a warming character and fruity, bittersweet finish.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings, Progress, Sovereign **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



KELHAM ISLAND PALE RIDER 5.2% ABV

Kelham Island Brewery, South Yorkshire. Est. 1990
This golden-coloured, award-winning beer is brewed using a blend of the finest malts and American hops, resulting in a fresh citrus nose, ample hints of fruit and a smooth, refreshing juicy malt character.
Hops: Cascade, Citra, Columbus, Willamette **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



THEAKSTON OLD PECULIER 5.6% ABV

Theakston Brewery, North Yorkshire. Est. 1827
This dark ruby beer is one of the world's classic beers. It has a rich, full-bodied flavour, with subtle cherry and rich fruit overtones, plus a smooth, lasting finish.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles, Target **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



MARSTON'S OLD EMPIRE IPA 5.7% ABV

Marston's Brewery, Staffordshire. Est. 1834
This golden beer is brewed in the style of a traditional IPA, with plenty of crisp citrus hop aromas, a subtle malt character and generous hop flavours emerging in the bittersweet finish.
Hops: Cascade, Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings, Herkules, Progress, Sovereign **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



THORNBRIDGE JAIPUR 5.9% ABV

Thornbridge Brewery, Derbyshire. Est. 2005
This golden, American-style IPA has a complex hop experience, with a building hoppiness in the mouth which bursts with powerful citrus fruit flavours, culminating in a surprisingly smooth finish.
Hops: Ahtanum, Cascade, Centennial, Chinook, Columbus, Simcoe **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



GREENE KING ABBOT RESERVE 6.5% ABV

Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799
This occasionally brewed deep copper-coloured beer has a fruit cake aroma, leading to a rich, full-bodied flavour, bursting with malt, biscuit, toffee and fruit notes, all balanced by an emerging bitterness.
Hops: Challenger, First Gold, Fuggles **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)

ILKLEY MARY JANE 3.5% ABV
 Ilkley Brewery, West Yorkshire. Est. 2009
 This straw-coloured pale ale has inviting floral and pine aromas, complemented by crisp citrus and grassy flavours, leading to a balanced bitterness in the finish.
Hops: Amarillo, Cascade **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



PURPLE MOOSE MADOG'S ALE 3.7% ABV
 Purple Moose Brewery, Gwynedd. Est. 2005
 This amber-coloured ale, a silver-medal winner in the 2017 CAMRA Champion Beer of Wales competition, has a crisp, malty flavour, leading to a dry, bitter finish.
Hops: Goldings, Pioneer **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



BURTON BRIDGE GOLDEN DELICIOUS 3.8% ABV
 Burton Bridge Brewery, Staffordshire. Est. 1982
 This light golden-coloured beer is delicately hopped to provide a refreshing and easy-drinking character, complemented by a dry, bitter finish.
Hops: Challenger, Styrian **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



BOWMAN WALLOPS WOOD 4.0% ABV
 Bowman Ales, Hampshire. Est. 2006
 This chestnut-coloured beer has a pleasing, delicate aroma, leading to a predominantly malty flavour, balanced by subtle hop notes and a hoppy finish.

 Hadrian Border Brewery, Newcastle upon Tyne. Est. 1992
 This amber-coloured beer is brewed with a blend of different malt and hop varieties, resulting in a balanced, well-rounded and refreshing character.

LYMESTONE STONE FACED 4.0% ABV
 Limestone Brewery, Staffordshire. Est. 2008
 This copper-coloured beer is brewed using a blend of dark and crystal malts to deliver a chewy toffee character, balanced by fruit and berry flavours, along with pine and citrus hop notes.

NOTTINGHAM LEGEND 4.0% ABV
 The Nottingham Brewery, Nottinghamshire. Est. 2000
 This traditional copper-coloured best bitter has a rounded, well-balanced flavour, with biscuit notes on the palate and a long, pleasing, fruity finish.

OAKHAM INFERNO 4.0% ABV
 Oakham Ales, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1993
 This golden ale has a full hop aroma, leading to a complex flavour bursting with citrus and fruity hop notes, resulting in a dry, refreshing, lasting bitter finish.

TITANIC BLACK ICE 4.1% ABV
 Titanic Brewery, Staffordshire. Est. 1985
 This is a truly sumptuous black IPA, with an inviting aroma, powerfully hopped to provide pleasing citrus notes and a balance to the underlying fruit and malt flavours.

DORSET JURASSIC 4.2% ABV
 Dorset Brewery, Dorset. Est. 1995
 This amber-coloured ale delivers aromas of grapefruit and cedar, leading to a crisp and refreshing character, with apricot flavours, along with a clean, lasting finish.

ENEFELD IRON BREW 4.2% ABV
 Enfield Brewery, London. Est. 2016
 This ruby-red beer has a deeply complex malt foundation, delivering the flavour of a higher-strength beer, balanced by floral hop notes and a clean bitterness, leading to a rich, lasting finish.
Hops: Cascade, First Gold **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



GREAT NEWSOME PRICKY BACK OTCHAN 4.2% ABV
 Great Newsome Brewery, East Yorkshire. Est. 2007
 This golden-coloured beer has a nutty, toffee aroma, with complex butterscotch and mild citrus notes in its medium-bodied flavour, leading to a satisfying bitterness in the finish.
Hops: Cascade, Northern Brewer, Pilgrim **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



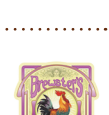
HANLONS YELLOW HAMMER 4.2% ABV

 This straw-coloured golden ale has a complex hop character, delivering citrus hop aromas and hints of tropical fruits and honey in the flavour, completed by a dry, refreshing finish.

STRATHAVEN OLD MORTALITY 4.2% ABV

 This chestnut-brown beer is brewed in the tradition of Scottish 80/- beers, with the delicate floral aroma leading to a spicy toffee flavour and a bittersweet, malty finish.

 Brewster's Brewery, Lincolnshire. Est. 1998
 This copper-coloured ale has a rich malt and citrus hop aroma, leading to a full-bodied, hoppy flavour, with light roasted notes and a satisfying, zesty finish.
Hops: Cascade, Centennial, Fuggles **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



EXE VALLEY FRYER'S THIRST 4.3% ABV
 Exe Valley Brewery, Devon. Est. 1984
 This golden ale is brewed with West Country malt, spring water and a fine blend of hop varieties, resulting in a pleasing hoppy nose, full-bodied flavour and bitter finish.
Hops: Azacca, Challenger, Cluster, Magnum **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



SUMMERSKILLS TAMAR 4.3% ABV
 Summerskills Brewery, Devon. Est. 1990
 This amber ale has a full Goldings hop aroma and nutty flavour, with plenty of fruit, while its malt flavours combine with its blend of hops to supply a refreshing finish.
Hops: First Gold, Pioneer, Styrian Goldings **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



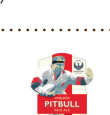
COACH HOUSE INNKEEPERS 4.5% ABV
 Coach House Brewery, Cheshire. Est. 1991
 This full-flavoured, ruby-coloured beer has a full, malty palate, balanced by a crisp hop flavour which gradually emerges through to the finish.
Hops: Admiral **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



EVAN EVANS WRECKER 4.5% ABV
 Evan Evans Brewery, Carmarthenshire. Est. 2004
 This deep amber-coloured beer combines a blend of malts with UK and US hop varieties, resulting in a full-bodied (yet easy-drinking) character, with a malty flavour and a fruity hop finish.
Hops: Fuggles, Magnum, Northdown, Willamette **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), rye (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



WIMBLEDON PITBULL 4.5% ABV
 Wimbledon Brewery, London. Est. 2015
 This amber-coloured beer is brewed using solely UK ingredients, providing subtle mango and forest fruit aromas, overlaying a crisp, balanced malt palate and resulting in a citrus finish.
Hops: Ernest, Fuggles, Golding, Jester, Olcana **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), oats (GLUTEN)



FLACK MANOR BLACK JACK 4.6% ABV
 Flack Manor Brewery, Hampshire. Est. 2010
 This smooth, dark ruby beer has rich aromas of toasted malts, with an initial sweetness in its flavour, followed by a lingering hop finish and hazelnut notes.
Hops: Fuggles, Goldings **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



LODDON HOCUS POCUS OLD ALE 4.6% ABV
 Loddon Brewery, Oxfordshire. Est. 2002
 This ruby-red, traditional, old-ale-style beer has a wonderfully hoppy aroma from its blend of hops, complementing the deep malt flavour to deliver a rich, smooth character.
Hops: Fuggles, Goldings **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



BANKS & TAYLOR'S CROOKED HOOKER 4.7% ABV
 B&T Brewery, Bedfordshire. Est. 1981
 Brewed to celebrate the Six Nations Championship, this scrummy beer is bronze in colour, with a superb balance of malt and hops, resulting in a dry, malty finish.
Hops: Challenger **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



GADDS' SHE SELLS SEA SHELLS 4.7% ABV
 The Ramsgate Brewery, Kent. Est. 2002
 This golden beer has an inviting honey and grapefruit aroma. This develops into a zesty, fresh hop flavour and a refreshing character, leading to a clean, crisp and bitter finish.
Hops: Cascade, Saaz **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), rye (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



MAXIM DOUBLE MAXIM 4.7% ABV
 Maxim Brewery, County Durham. Est. 2007
 This beer was first brewed in 1901 – the oldest-surviving example of a traditional northeastern brown ale. The full aroma leads to a balance of ripe grain and spicy hops in the flavour, resulting in a long, bittersweet finish.
Hops: Goldings **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



COTLEIGH OLD BUZZARD 4.8% ABV
 Cotleigh Brewery, Somerset. Est. 1979
 This mahogany-coloured beer has a roasted chocolate malt and dry, nutty flavour, with hints of biscuit and fruit, leading to a smooth, dry, smoky finish.
Hops: Goldings, Northern Brewer, Progress **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



FROME GULP IPA 4.8% ABV
 Frome Brewery, Somerset. Est. 1999
 This deep golden beer is a traditional English IPA, with floral, citrus and hoppy aromas leading to hints of honey and caramel in the flavour, complemented by a full, complex bitterness.
Hops: Admiral, Perle **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



GODDARDS FUGGLE DEE-DUM 4.8% ABV
 Goddards Brewery, Isle of Wight. Est. 1993
 This is chestnut-red in colour, with aromas of roasted malt and smoky, spicy hops, leading to a nutty taste and a pleasing, light, fruity hop dryness in the flavour.
Hops: Fuggles, Progress **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



GREEN JACK LURCHER STOUT 4.8% ABV
 Green Jack Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 2003
 This rich, smooth stout is black in colour, with a blackcurrant aroma, hoppy bitterness and roasted notes in the flavour, leading to a subtle sweetness in the finish.
Hops: Bramling Cross, Challenger **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



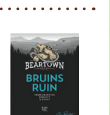
QUANTOCK PLASTERED PHEASANT 4.8% ABV
 Quantock Brewery, Somerset. Est. 2008
 This traditional, rich, warming porter is dark amber in colour, with plenty of fruit in the aroma and a smooth flavour, plus hints of coffee and toffee on the palate.
Hops: Phoenix, Willamette **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



SAMBROOK'S POWERHOUSE PORTER 4.9% ABV
 Sambrook's Brewery, London. Est. 2008
 This ruby porter, named in honour of Battersea Power Station, has aromas of toasted malt and winter fruits, leading to a rich dark chocolate flavour, with hints of caramel, coffee and liquorice.
Hops: Boadicea, Challenger, Fuggles **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



BEARTOWN BRUINS RUIN 5.0% ABV
 Beartown Brewery, Cheshire. Est. 1994
 This amber-coloured beer has a robust, nutty aroma, leading to a full, malty character, balanced by plenty of hop flavour and a dry, lingering finish.
Hops: Admiral, Challenger **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



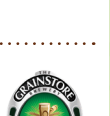
BRIGHTSIDE NORTH TRAIL 5.0% ABV
 Brightside Brewery, Manchester. Est. 2009
 This light amber-coloured beer is packed full of top-quality US hops, delivering fresh and vibrant citrus, ripe fruit and pine, in both the aroma and flavour, resulting in a fresh, zesty finish.
Hops: Amarillo, Columbus, Equanot, Mosaic **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



BROUGHTON PROPER IPA 5.0% ABV
 Broughton Ales, Scottish Borders. Est. 1979
 This golden beer is an American-style IPA, brewed using a mix of New World hops and traditional brewing methods to deliver generous floral notes and a full, hoppy character.
Hops: Amarillo, Cascade, Chinook **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN)



GRAINSTORE TEN FIFTY 5.0% ABV
 Grainstore Brewery, Rutland. Est. 1995
 This full-strength, mahogany-coloured beer has a fine balance of hop bitterness and malty sweetness, creating a potent (yet easily drinkable) character.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



KIRKSTALL DISSOLUTION IPA 5.0% ABV
 Kirkstall Brewery, West Yorkshire. Est. 2011
 This pale golden is a classic IPA, with a smooth caramel flavour which gives balance to the resolute, intensely hoppy kick and citrus finish delivered by the blend of US hops.
Hops: Centennial, Chinook, Columbus, Eureka **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



NAYLOR'S NORTHERN GOLD 5.0% ABV
 Naylor's Brewery, West Yorkshire. Est. 2005
 This golden IPA has a full, floral, hoppy aroma and citrus hop notes in the flavour, finely complementing its rich maltiness, resulting in a full, balanced character.
Hops: Cascade **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



NELSON SHIPWRECKED 5.0% ABV
 Nelson Brewery, Kent. Est. 1995
 This pale golden ale is brewed with a blend of four UK hop varieties, to deliver a robust hoppy aroma and flavour, balanced by subtle malt notes, before late bitterness in the finish.
Hops: Admiral, Bullion, Sovereign, UK Cascade **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



SALOPIAN ECHOES OF SYMMETRY 5.0% ABV
 Salopian Brewery, Shropshire. Est. 1995
 This black stout features a peppering array of dark malts, resulting in aromas of dark chocolate and mocha, a bold, dry body and a rich, malty and fulfilling flavour.
Hops: Challenger, Chinook **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), oats (GLUTEN)



CAIRNGORM WILDCAT 5.1% ABV
 Cairngorm Brewery, Highlands. Est. 1997
 This smooth dark amber-coloured ale has a complex malt, fruit and hop flavour. It is strong and distinctive, like the powerful, sleek Scottish wildcat, after which it is named.
Hops: Challenger, Fuggles **Allergens:** barley (GLUTEN), wheat (GLUTEN)



MILESTONE FLETCHERS 5.2% ABV
 Milestone Brewery, Nottinghamshire. Est. 2005
 This light golden ale is brewed with New Zealand hop varieties, delivering a bold, aromatic, fruity and full-bodied character, with crisp citrus and gooseberry flavours.
